

BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 10, 2009

Elaine Soule seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken and the motion carried by majority vote. The polling location will be changed to Randolph Union High School Murray Auditorium.

Dennis Brown made a motion to approve the addition of the applicants to the voter checklist. The motion was seconded by Elaine Soule. A voice vote was taken and the motion carried by majority vote.
