A joint meeting between The Highway Advisory & The Police Advisory Committees was held on Thursday, June 26, 2008 with two items on the agenda for discussion.

1) Merchants Row Parking.

All the shops on Merchants Row were surveyed with regards to two hour parking restrictions. Observations were made over a two week period as to available parking.

After discussion at the joint meeting it is the recommendation of these committees **NOT** <sup>AT THIS TIME</sup> to require a two hour parking limit. When the streetscape is finished it is suggested that parking lines be painted on both sides of the street. A handicapped spot will also be assigned on the N W corner near Patrick's Place. Further, it is recommended that a new One Way sign be fashioned at the pleasant St. corner for easier and better visibility.

2) Hull Street Stop Sign.

Met with complainant in regards to details.

Discussion by the joint committees resulted in the recommendation that at this time **NO** stop sign is necessary. We do however recommend that a letter from the Town Manager to all the businesses on Hull St. be drafted asking their employees to please watch their speed on both Hull St. and Randolph Ave. with a CC to Chief Krakowiecki. The Chief indicated that he will monitor the situation.
