ADDENDUM ARTICLE I. Shall the town school district of Randolph, which the State Board of Education has found necessary to include in the proposed Orange Southwest Unified District (OSUD), join with the school districts of Braintree, Brookfield, and Randolph Union High School, which the State Board of Education has found necessary to include in the proposed Orange Southwest Unified District (OSUD), for the purpose of forming a unified district, as provided in Title 16, Vermont Statutes Annotated?		
ARTICLE III. Shall the voters of the Randolph School District approve the school board to expend \$4,727,663 , which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? This represents a 3.38% increase from the previous year. It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$13,384 per equalized pupil.
