Together, we're building a trained Peer Support and specialized clinical team. Our goals are to enhance overall safety, provide expert response to critical incidents, and support the wellness of officers and first responders in Vermont.

WHO: You! Any Vermont police chief and officer with an interest in peer support.

WHAT: 50 officers and chiefs from around Vermont and 40 specialized clinicians will be trained together to build EAPFirst. **The goal of this team is to expand the trained peer support base in Vermont;** we want at least 2-3 trained peers and 2-3 specialized clinicians per county.
