

## Police Committee Meeting Minutes

October 26, 2016

1704: Call to Order. Present Trini Brassard, Tom Harty, Sgt. Stalnaker, Officer Lambert, George Trask, Rita Hull, Officer Matt Chin and Larry Richburg, Paul Quealy (GMC), Jessica Ryan (GMC), Marjorie Ryerson, Irene Schaefer, Revell Allen, Tom Schersten. Rita Hull absent.

1705: Public comments – None made.

1705: Discussion on Gifford Medical Center. Officer Lambert introduced Paul and Jessica to the group. Spoke of safety planning and calls for service at GMC. Officer Lambert mentioned partnering with GMC on some community programs. Paul is the emergency preparedness coordinator. Jess is director of nursing. Discussion on response to GMC and mental health patients and increased calls for that community.

1747: Policies – Response to Resistance/Use of Force – Added & defined less-lethal Munitions (Use and documentation). Tom Harty made a motion to send policy to select board. Larry Richburg seconded and the vote was carried 4-0-0.

Supervision of Persons Experiencing a Mental Health Crisis or during an Emergency Exam Process – Changes made after CMC workers voiced concerns over some language. Copy of policy also given to GMC for review for any concerns they have. Tabled until next meeting.

Cell Phone Policy and Internal Affairs policies still pending.

1819: Public question from Marjorie Ryerson on situation on current burglaries. Officer Lambert issued the press release statement.

1820: Question from Trini about Mobile Video Camera's and if it has been passed by Select Board. Tabled until November.

1823: 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing: Already working with CMC & GMC. Possible issue with RUHS and touring campus. Sgt. Stalnaker will speak with David Barnett. Possible groups to work with is Tom Schersten and the Randolph Area Opiate Response Team, Chamber of Commerce, Clergy groups, RACDC, Rec Department, Restorative Justice and Kym Anderson, OCSD.

1846: Other Business/Topics: Expanding district brought up by Ton Schersten.
