Randolph Tobacco-Free Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to improve public health through protection from exposure to second hand smoke and smoking products. The Town of Randolph believes that tobacco use in the proximity of Town facilities is detrimental to health and can be offensive to those using and working in such facilities and open areas.

Scope:

It is the policy of the Town of Randolph, Vermont that tobacco use is prohibited in and in the vicinity of all public facilities in the Town and permitted within twenty (20) feet of any building entrance or exit doorway and vented windows.

Designated "Smoking Areas" will be determined for facilities where practical. Smoking as defined in this policy will only be permitted in designated "Smoking Areas." Appropriate signage will indicate these "Smoking Areas" and receptacles will be provided for the deposit of smoking materials.

Smoking is defined as the act of lighting, smoking, or carrying a lighted or smoldering cigar, cigarette, or pipe of any kind or using smokeless products such as snuff, chewing tobacco or similar products, in the vicinity of public facilities.
