Operations Status: There was more to do since Grievance Day. We are still waiting for Coxon's blue prints. On Friday August 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will review grievances, then the notices will be done, and the Grand List signed.

Pat had talked to 2<sup>nd</sup> Branch about lots on Route 14, no change.

Dr. Coxon, we need to check measurements and look at blueprints. The appraiser who did the bank appraisal used inside dimensions instead of the outside dimensions, we need to adjust appraisal with correct square footage.

Gilman, has no change.

The Johnson horse barn is now classified as a farm building so it will be assessed like the other classified farm buildings in town.

There is a new parcel to add in town; Velco Fiber Optic Line. It is appraised like a state utility, and adds about \$600,000 to the Grand List.

There was a Stock Farm Road Lot that was not an official appeal; once we get some more valid sales we are going to review the land values up there. No Change.

Sam Sammis brought in some papers earlier in the year, and sent in a letter, but it was not an appeal for value, Pat tried to get together, but never heard from Sammis after that.

Meeting was recessed until Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>.
