Pursuant to and by the authority of Chapter 59, Title 24 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated provided the legislative body of a municipality may adopt the following ordinance or rules to provide for the general health and welfare of the municipality.

Which ordinances and rules shall have the full force and effect of the law the Selectboard of the Town of Randolph do hereby adopt the following ordinance and regulation viz:

**Purpose:** This ordinance is adopted as a supplement to and not as a substitution for, any Vermont Statutes and Regulations with reference to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and non-prescribed regulated drugs or any Randolph Ordinance and Regulations with reference to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverage and non-prescribed regulated drug.

This Ordinance revises all former alcohol and non prescribed regulated drugs ordinance passed in the Town of Randolph on its effective date, sixty days after its adopted date of October 21, 2003.

It will take effect on Saturday, December 20, 2003, unless a petition signed by at least five percent of the voters of the Town of Randolph is filed with the Town Clerk by 4:30 PM on Friday, December 5, 2003, asking for a vote to disapprove the ordinance. If a petition is received, the Town of Randolph's Selectboard will warn a special meeting and the voters may vote on that question.

Alcohol & Drug

Alcohol and Regulated Drugs Ordinance

Pursuant to and by the authority of Chapter 59, Title 24 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated provided the legislative body of a municipality may adopt the following ordinance or rules to provide for the general health and welfare of the municipality.

Which ordinances and rules shall have the full force and effect of the law, the Selectboard of the Town of Randolph do hereby revise the following ordinance and regulation viz:

Section I: Purpose—This ordinance is adopted as a supplement to, and not as a substitution for, any Vermont Statutes and Regulations with reference to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and non-prescribed regulated drugs or any Randolph Ordinance and Regulations with reference to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and non-prescribed regulated drugs.

Section II: Possession

- a. The use, possession or dispensing of alcoholic beverages on any property owned or insured by the Town of Randolph is prohibited except by special permit of the Liquor Control Board of the Town of Randolph, VT. Such permits shall be granted on a case-by-case basis only to a licensed caterer in the State of Vermont who is covered by "Dram Shop Insurance". In addition to the above, the Liquor Control Board shall attach such conditions as, in their judgement, are required to protect the public health, safety or welfare of the Town of Randolph, VT.
- b. No person shall be in unauthorized possession of a non-prescribed regulated drug on any Town owned or insured property, land or within Town owned or insured buildings, or on or within Town owned or insured vehicles or equipment.
- c. Nothing containing herein shall be construed to restrict or prohibit transportation of those items on Town roads or Highways so long as such transportation does not otherwise violate statutes of the State of Vermont or the Ordinances of the Town of Randolph in full force and effect.

Section III: Consumption—No person shall possess or consume alcoholic beverages and/or possess, consume, inject or inhale non-prescribed regulated drugs while in attendance at any meeting, activity, program, or similar function held or sponsored by, or directly affiliated or associated with the Town of Randolph.

Section IV: Under the Influence—No person shall be under the influence of or impaired by alcoholic beverages, intoxicating liquor, or non-prescribed regulated drugs of Town or insured property or while attending Town functions.

Section V: Penalties—a person who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$500.00 or imprisoned not more than 30 (thirty) days, or both.
