Approval is hereby given for the granting of a permit under the provisions of V.S.A. Title 23, Sec. 1400a, and any amendments thereto, covering the operations of motor vehicles over local highways and bridges with gross loads as follows:

Approved for the following: All town highways, except those with bridges with wooden decks. Bridges, which have 16,000 lb. weights by state statute. Weight limits on the covered bridges are as follows: Braley 4,000 lbs.; Gifford 6,000 lbs.; and Kingsbury 4,000 lbs.

The following restrictions apply: Special weight limits will be in effect during mud season, typically March 15 thru May 15. During this time, a day-by-day permission will be granted by the Highway Superintendent or Town Manager on a case-by case basis. Permit holders must first attempt to contact the Highway Superintendent for permission during mud season. Excess weight truck travel is **not permitted** on the following at any time: Highland Avenue and Maple Street.

This approval shall be effective for a period not to exceed one-year, and is valid from the date of issuance until expiring on March 31, 20___. If this is a fleet permit, this approval covers all vehicles bearing the company name. If the permit is to cover unmarked company trucks, please attach a list to this form giving the year, make, VIN number, maximum weight, and registration number.

The holder of a permit shall be liable for any damage to highways or bridges per V.S.A. Title 23, Sec. 1400a(c) and is required to furnish the municipality a valid Certificate of Insurance in the following amounts: a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage. **Listing of unmarked vehicles and Certificate of Insurance that lists the Town of Randolph as the Certificate Holder, must accompany overweight permit applications. Failure to submit with the application, or with missing or lesser or coverage limits, may result in a delay in processing of permit.**
