All budgets are for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

Article 1. Shall the town voters residing in the **Police District** authorize the total expenditure of **\$524,102** for Police District Operations and Capital Expenses of which an estimated \$324,294 shall be raised by taxes; an estimated 199,808 shall be from other revenue?
