

## **Randolph Town Plan - Change History**

**June 26<sup>th</sup> 2017** Planning Commission began work on revising the 2013 Town plan.

**January 17<sup>th</sup> 2018** Planning Commission began working with Two Rivers Ottawaquechee Regional Commission to include the following elements in the town plan: flood resiliency, forest block, habitat corridors, village and downtown designations, relationship to other plans and, if needed enhanced energy.

**July 9<sup>th</sup> 2018** Hearing by Planning Commission and final revisions incorporated for submission to Select Board.

**September 13<sup>th</sup> 2018** Hearing by Select Board. Select Board adopted the plan with minor grammatical changes and agreed to add color front cover and a revised introduction with color photos.

**April 16<sup>th</sup> 2019** The Planning Commission established a 7-member Enhanced Energy Planning Subcommittee to determine if the Town needed an enhanced energy plan.

**June 4<sup>th</sup> 2019** Hearing by Planning Commission.

**June 13<sup>th</sup> 2019** Approved by Planning Commission with minor changes and sent to Select Board.

**August 8<sup>th</sup> 2019** Hearing by Select Board, approved with minor change and sent to Two Rivers Ottawaquechee Regional Commission for final approval.

**August 21<sup>st</sup> 2019** Two Rivers Ottawaquechee Regional Commission voted to Confirm Randolph's planning process.

**September 25<sup>th</sup> 2019** Two Rivers Ottawaquechee Regional Commission unanimously approved Randolph's Town Plan.
