1. Tennis Courts-

- b. Resurfacing tennis courts/basketball court will be completed by the end of August.

Pool Updates-

- a. The leak has been found in the plumbing pipes located on the river side of pool
- b. There is a need to redo all skimmers so they are not at the frost heave line.
- c. Process for repairs have begun and will continue throughout the summer.

Disc Golf –

- a. Trails have become more defined by cutting old brush.
- b. Mini Golf members have added quaint additions to trails keeping with not disturbing area.
- c. More Trails for BMX are being made. Running parallel to Disc trails.

Camp Pavilion v. Ball Fields-

- a. Camp Pavilion reservation signs have been mounted at the Picnic area along with reservations instructions for the public.
- b. Talk of possibly creating another area or upgrading the area near the river next to the play equipment for reservations.
- c. Ball Fields (Girls & Boys) need to be upgraded.
