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32 **4. Open Meeting Law Training with VLCT.**

40 **5. Public Hearing – VCDP Implementation Grant for RACDC Salisbury Square Project.**

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44 Julie from RACDC gave an overview of the \$1 million Salisbury Square grant project. The
45 Town will be the formal applicant for the grant, though the money will be passed through the
46 Town and on to RACDC.
